Lunch Time: Please wait until Monday August 21nd to visit and eat lunch with your child. We encourage parent involvement throughout the school year but this will allow adequate time to get lunchroom procedures in place for all students. If there is a special occasion (Birthday) prior to this, we will make exceptions of course. Students will regularly be told to treat the lunchroom environment as if they are having a sit down dinner at home or in a restaurant. Please encourage table manners, appropriate voice volume, a healthy nutrition, and cleaning up after themselves (table & floor).

Money & Forms: When turning in money or forms for field trips, school fundraisers, or special events, always place it in a sealed envelope with the student name on the outside. Envelopes containing money should always be placed in the hand of a teacher by the student or parent. Each homeroom teacher will also have a basket for notes and other items that do not contain money. Students need to be responsible and move these items from their folder to the proper location.

Homeroom Parents: Each homeroom will need a volunteer for room parent. The room parent will help organize and plan classroom parties, and communicate with our PTA about events for teachers and students throughout the year. Rooms may also have a team of room parents that work together, but one needs to be the point of contact for PTA and the teacher. Make sure you let your homeroom teacher know if you are interested in this role.
